A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CREEDMOOR, TEXAS, ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND TWO (2) ALDERMEN, AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

**WHEREAS**, the terms of office for the positions of Mayor and two (2) Aldermanic places on the Board of Alderman of the City of Creedmoor, Texas, will expire in 2025; and

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary to hold a general election to fill these positions on the uniform election date in November 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen finds it appropriate to formally order the election and authorize related actions;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CREEDMOOR, TEXAS:

#### 1. Election Ordered:

A general election is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two (2) Aldermen to the Board of Aldermen.

#### 2. Candidate Filing Deadline:

Qualified individuals may file an application for a place on the ballot with the City Secretary. The deadline to file is Monday, August 18, 2025 at 5:00 p.m.

#### 3. Early Voting:

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and the County Elections Administrator's guidelines. The dates, times, and locations for early voting will be established and announced by Travis County.

#### 4. Polling Places:

Election day polling places will be established in coordination with the Travis County Elections Division and in compliance with state law.

#### 5. Notice and Posting:

This Resolution shall be posted at all official posting locations of the City and published on the City's official website or electronic platforms, as required by law.

If no more than one candidate files for any office referenced herein by the applicable deadline, the City Secretary is authorized to cancel the election for that office pursuant to the Texas Election Code.
